



Protocol


- Rice
 - Placed on trays & roads
- Decoys
 - Numbers
- Placement
 - Away from habitat





Non-blackbirds

- Concerns
 - Species
 - Sparrows
- DRC-1339 Label
 - Registered in ND
 - Zero tolerance







Predators

- Avian
 - Hawks

- Mammals
 - Raccoons





Success

- Electric fence
- Trap grouping
- Blackbirds without non-blackbirds


Tray Visits

Blackbird Vs. Non-blackbird Tray Visits Non-blackbird 5% Blackbird 95%


Feeding Blackbirds
